Background of the training program:

Psychoactive Substance use related problems are one of the oldest problems in the world. Tobacco, alcohol, inhalants, cannabis, heroin, sedatives and other drugs are abused by people. Due to the influence of media, wrong role models, and peer pressure, youth are vulnerable for use of substances. Tobacco products (cigarettes, hans, panparag etc), alcohol, cannabis etc. are the common substances used by students. Youth especially students think using these substances is a symbol of pride. They have a difficulty to differentiate healthy and unhealthy habits. The usage of drugs may gradually lead to misuse and which may in turn result in addiction. There is a need to teach youth about choosing healthy habits, handling peer pressure, high-risk situations etc.
