ORDINANCES GOVERNING ACADEMIC AND ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

**(As approved by the Department of Higher Education Ministry of Human
Resource Development, Govt. of India**

Vide letter F.No.57-5/2011 – Desk (U), dated 28-03-2012)

Central University of Karnataka has invited the applications for the post of Professor, Associate Professor and Assistant Professor vide Employment Notification No. 18/2015, dated: 28-10-2015.

As per the University Ordinance No.18, Procedure/Norms for appointment to the posts of Professor, Associate Professor and Assistant Professor (Act Section 28(1)((0).

1. The terms and conditions with regard to the minimum qualifications and terms and conditions as prescribed by the UGC from time to time, shall be followed.
 - i. In addition to the above, the Vice Chancellor may prescribe, in consultation with the concerned Dean and Head of the Department, to the Academic Council such specification or any other condition as required for the post to be filled up.
2. The university will have the right to restrict the number of candidates to be called for interview, based on the recommendations of the Screening Committee constituted as per the Regulations for this purpose, to a reasonable number on the basis of qualifications and experience higher than the minimum prescribed or by any other condition that it may deem fit.
3. In accordance with the above 1 & 2, the University has shortlisted the candidates after scrutiny for interview based on eligibility and merit calculated for academic performance.
4. In case of Assistant Professor the candidates are called for interview in the ratio of 1:20. The marks scored by each candidate for academic performance (50 Marks) is displayed on Website along with criteria for allotment of marks.

*Wherever relevant to any specific discipline, the API score for paper in refereed journal would be augmented as follows: (i) indexed journals – by 5 points; (ii) papers with impact factor between 1 and 2 by 10 points; (iii) papers with impact factor between 2 and 5 by 15 points; (iv) papers with impact factor between 5 and 10 by 25 points.

** If a paper presented in Conference/Seminar is published in the form of Proceedings, the points would accrue for the publication (III (a)) and not under presentation (III (e)(ii)).

Notes.

1. It is incumbent on the Coordination Committee proposed in these Regulations and the University to prepare and publicize within six months subject-wise lists of journals, periodicals and publishers under categories IIIA and B. Till such time, screening/selection committees will assess and verify the categorization and scores of publications.
2. The API for joint publications will have to be calculated in the following manner: Of the total score for the relevant category of publication by the concerned

teacher, the first/Principal author and the corresponding author/supervisor/mentor of the teacher would share equally 60% of the total points and the remaining 40% would be shared equally by all other authors.

3. The parameters listed in table of category-III (Research and Academic contributions) shall have following capping in relation to the total API score claimed by the candidates:-

• III (A) : Research papers (Journals, etc)	30%
• III (B) : Research publications (Books, etc)	25%
• III (C): Research Projects	20%
• III (D): Research Guidance	10%
• III (E): Training Courses and Conf/Seminar, etc	15%
