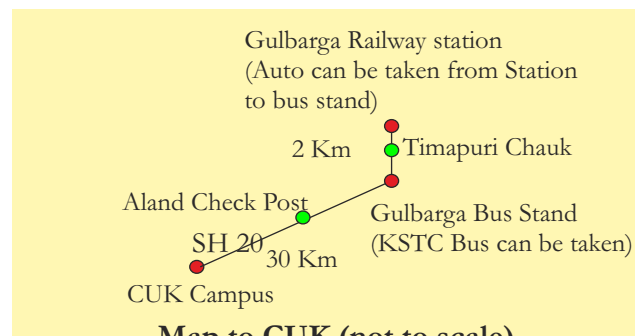

EARTH RESOURCES AND SUSTAINABILITY

Resources are important for the development of a region and community, however optimum and proper utilization of resources still remains a challenge. At different intervals, the economic demand for minerals, water, soil and food have played a central role in the global neoliberal model of development that frames the outcome of existing and emerging economies. In these lines resources and sustainability is an ongoing debate not limited to build and improve the ongoing frameworks on resource sustainability, but also questioning its access, allocation and distribution while discussing the policy agendas.

In today's context large scale extraction of mineral resources, consumption of water and its uneven accessibility to community, degradation in soil productivity due to change in climatic conditions and availability of food are the major challenges of regions in South Asia. The concept of sustainability need to be questioned as resources have become valued, marketised and commodified, with a range of unforeseen consequences.

With the overview on continuing discussions for sustainable development goal, SDG (Sustainable Development Goal) agendas focusing toward revival in economic growth, protection of environment, and promotion of peace and good governance. This seminar aims to forge a scholarly approach toward different type of resources and its sustainable use. The prime focus is placed on mineral, water, soil and food as resources, its scarcity and availability and for its sustainable utilization. The seminar aim is to bring academic work that encompasses issues surrounding resources and sustainability using multi disciplinary methods.

THEMES

The seminar will provide an opportunity for the participants to present their ideas and research in the following themes.

- 1) Mineral Resources
- 2) Water Resources
- 3) Soil Resources
- 4) Food Security

GUIDELINES TO THE AUTHORS

Abstract should precisely highlight the research outcome. This should be submitted in MS word in 250 words, and should strictly be in the following format: Title (Times New Roman, capital, bold with font size 14); Author(s) name with affiliation (name of the institution, place and email id of the corresponding author; Body of the abstract (Times New Roman, font size 12, with 4-5 key words). the abstract should be e mailed at **ERAS.CUK@GMAIL.COM**

ORAL PRESENTATION

Oral Presentation will be for selected candidates, four in each session. Candidates will be allowed to present for 15 minutes and 10 minutes will be given for discussion. The power point presentation may carry up to maximum of 30 slides.

FORMAT OF POSTER

- Poster size for display shall be (3 feet width and 4 feet height in portrait layout).
- The poster for day one should be posted on the stand by 11 am and remove by 5 pm same day.
- Plagiarism of any kind is ground for disqualification.
- Papers/posters should not have been presented, published or awarded in any form elsewhere.
- The peer review committee will screen the abstracts and reserves the rights for accepting/rejecting the abstracts.
