## **GENERAL NOTICE**

## Admission to UG courses at Central University of Karnataka for the academic year 2022-23

1. Central University of Karnataka has adopted NEP-2020. In the academic year 2022-23, the admission will be undertaken for the following six 4 Years-UG programmes:

- 2. The above UG courses will have multiple exits as per NEP 2020 and CUK regulations. Candidates preferring to take exit at the end of second semester will be getting Undergraduate certificate (in the field of learning/discipline) upon successful completion of all the courses in first two semesters followed by an additional 10 credits skill based course out of which 4 credits theory course and 6 credits of internships specified by the University. Candidates preferring to take exit at the end of fourth semester will be getting Undergraduate diploma (in the field of learning/discipline) upon successful completion of all the courses in first four semesters followed by an additional 10 credits skill based course out of which 4 credits theory course and 6 credits of internships specified by the University.
- 3. Equal number of the admitted students will be distributed between the two disciplines at the end of fourth semester depending on the merit-cum-choice and roster.
- 4. Based on the discipline/subject taken in the third year, B.Sc.(Physics), B.Sc.(Chemistry), B.Sc. (Life Sciences), B.Sc.(Geology), B.Sc.(Mathematics), B.Sc.(Computer Science), B.Sc (Psychology), B.A (English), B.Sc.(Geography), B.A (History), B.A.(Economics), or B.A. (Social Work) degree will be awarded upon exit at the end of sixth semester.

- 5. An individual seeking admission to a Bachelor's degree (Honours/Research) in a specified field of learning would normally have completed all requirements of the relevant three-year bachelor degree.
- 6. After completing the requirements of a three year Bachelor's degree, candidates who meet a minimum CGPA of 7.5 shall be allowed to continue studies in the fourth year of the undergraduate programme to pursue and complete the Bachelor's degree with Research. Otherwise, the candidate will be enrolled for Bachelor's (Honours) in the field of learning /discipline.
- 7. In the academic year 2022-23, the admission will be undertaken for the following three UG programmes as well. These three programmes do not have multiple exit options.

- 8. For the courses B.Tech. in Electronics and Communication and B.Tech. in Electrical Engineering, 50% seats will be filled on the basis of merit in the NTA-CUET (UG)-2022. The remaining 50% of the seats will be filled on the basis of performance in JEE–Main Exam (2022) who are eligible for writing JEE–Advanced 2022, the national level test conducted by the IITs for admission to all their UG programmes.
- 9. It is mandatory to register to the SAMARTH portal that will be displayed on the CUK web site shortly. Only the candidates who have appeared for CUET (UG) 2022 and JEE 2022 Mains qualified are eligible for registration. All candidates are required to pay the non-refundable registration fee as per the following categories.

10. The candidates applying under the reserved categories shall submit category Certificates (SC/ST/OBC Non-Creamy Layer Certificate/ EWS) issued by the competent authority in the prescribed format at the time of registration and produce the same in original for verification at the time of admission. The candidates are advised to visit the website for concerned certificate format.

- 11. All the prospective Candidates are advised to keep ready with good quality scanned copy (JPG/ pdf format, Size not exceeding 500kb for each document) of the following documents (as applicable) for uploading during online registration process.
  - Passport size Digital Photograph
  - Secondary School (Class 10th) Mark Sheet
  - Senior Secondary School/PUC-II (Class 12th) Mark Sheet or equivalent.
  - Valid Certificate for Date of Birth
  - Migration Certificate from last attended Board, if available
  - School Leaving Certificate/Transfer Certificate/, if available
  - Caste Certificates (ST/SC/OBC-NCL), EWS Certificates (if applicable, issued from the competent authority in GOI format).
  - Self-Declaration Form for those applying under OBC-NCL category, if applicable.
  - PWD/PH Certificate for those applying under the differently-abled category, (if applicable, issued from the competent authority in GOI format).
  - Certificate of Kashmiri Migrant & Kashmiri Pandits / Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non-migrants) for those applying under the Kashmiri Migrant quota (if applicable, issued from the competent authority in GOI format).
  - Certificate(s) as a proof of Ward of Defence Category, if applicable
  - Certificate(s) of representing International, National or State level events in any sport/ game for those applying under sports quota, if applicable
  - Certificate(s) related to NCC/NSS Category, if applicable
  - Kalyan Karnataka Region (371J) Certificate, if applicable
  - Undertaking form in the case of non-submission of any required Certificates.
  - Free-ship card for SC/ST candidates from free-ship sanctioning agencies, if applicable.
- 12. Ensuring the eligibility for applying to a particular programme will be the sole responsibility of the candidate. Please read the eligibility criteria and other requirements before submitting the registration form. Submission of online registration form is mandatory for the admission to the UG programme.
- 13. The registration through SAMARTH portal will be displayed on the CUK website shortly. Candidates are advised to visit the website regularly for further information and guidelines.
