INTRODUCTION

The Central university of Karnataka, has been established by the Parliament vide the Central Universities Act 2009 (No. 3-C of 2009) at Gulbarga. It is one of the 16 new Central Universities established by the Government of India during the UGC XI Plan Period.

The university was established in March 2009 and started functioning from the ground floor Hall of the Administrative Building of the Gulbarga University.

The activities undertaken by the university during the period April 2009 – March 2010 are presented in this Annual Report.

ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

The university initiated its academic activities from its year of inception (2009) by beginning a process of consultation with senior and distinguished academicians and experts on the courses to be stated, syllabi to be framed and the academic structure to be adopted in line with the provisions of the university Act.

Five Integrated courses were offered in Geography, Economics, Psychology, English and History with exit option after three years at B.A. (Hons.) level apart from M.A. in English and M.Phil. in Geography, Economics, Psychology, English and History.

The university appointed teaching faculty on visiting / contractual / guest basis and the admission process was initiated in June 2009 with classes for the first semester of M.A. (English) and M.Phil. (Economics, English and Psychology) commenced in September 2009.
