

- Final year and final / penultimate semester students of post graduate course in the stipulated discipline from any of the Universities incorporated by an Act of the Central or State legislature in India or other educational institutions established by an Act of Parliament or declared to be deemed as a University under Section 3 of UGC Act, 1956, or possess an equivalent qualification recognized by the Ministry of HRD, Government of India or approved by AICTE.
- Candidates should have consistent academic record of minimum 60% marks from class 10<sup>th</sup> onwards (for 10<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, Graduation & Post Graduation).
- Candidates should be completing post-graduation in the academic year 2019-20 within the minimum stipulated period of the course.
- As on date of recruitment process conducted by the Bank, candidate should have cleared all papers of previous years / semester of the qualifying examination with 60% of marks and all the papers pertaining to the subsequent semester(s) should be cleared along with the results of the final year / semester examination. The final year/semester examination should be cleared in the first chance itself.
- Candidates shall not exceed 26 years of age as on 01.11.2019 (Candidates should be born on or after 01.11.1993).
- Minimum percentage of marks prescribed for the examinations is not allowed to be rounded off (For example: a candidate who secured only 59.99% of marks will not be permitted to appear for the campus process in case the minimum stipulated percentage is 60%).
- Bank reserves the right to raise the minimum eligibility standard/ other norms
  etc. in order to restrict the number of candidates to be included in the
  selection process.

Note: Candidates should ensure that they are eligible to participate in the selection process as per the eligibility criteria stipulated by the Bank. If at any stage it was found that the candidate is ineligible for the post applied his / her candidature is liable to be cancelled at any stage, without notice & compensation.
