CORRIGENDUM - 2

1. In continuation to the Notification No. 23/2019 Dated 25/01/2019, for the notified post of Librarian and Asst. Librarian at Sl. No. 2 & 6 mentioned in the above Notification the following corrigendum point is issued revised details for the post and accordingly the details vide Notification No.23/2019 for the post of Librarian to be cancelled and to be read as per this corrigendum point as follows:

LIBRARIAN

Essential qualification :-

- i. A Master's Degree in Library Science /Information Science / Documentation with at least 55% marks or its equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed.
- ii. At least ten years as a Librarian at any level in University Library or ten years of teaching as Assistant/Associate Professor in Library Science or ten years' experience as a College Librarian.
- iii. Evidence of innovative library service, including the integration of ICT in a library.
- iv. A Ph.D. Degree in library Science / Information Science / Documentation / Archives and Manuscripts-Keeping.

ASST. LIBRARIAN

Essential:

- (i) A Master's degree in Library Science, Information Science or Documentation Science or an equivalent professional degree, with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed).
- (ii) A consistently good academic record, with knowledge of computerization of a library.
- (iii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the

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University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil/Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be:

Provided that the, candidates registered for the Ph.D. degree prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Byelaws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree, and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:-

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in the regular mode
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) Open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one is in a referred journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D work in conferences/seminars sponsored / funded /supported by the UGC/ICSSR/CSIR or any similar agency.

Note:

- (i) The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.
- (ii) NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for candidates in such Master's Programmes for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.

2. Self-calculated and self-certified API Score card / Academic-Research Score for the Academic positions of Professor, Librarian and Asst. Librarian has to be duly filled and submitted by the candidates with relevant enclosures as per UGC Regulations on minimum qualifications for appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and measures for the maintenance of standards in Higher Education 2018, published in Gazette of India : Extraordinary on 18/07/2018 (Attached as Annexure-I) along with relevant self-attested testimonials with proper indexing and reference.
3. **Call letters and other correspondence for attending the interview, etc., will be sent only to the eligible candidates by Email only.**
4. **Candidates must write their Email ID neatly and correctly for mailing written examination/ interview/appointment letter as attachment as applicable. The e-**

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mail date will be considered as the official date of dispatch and receipt of communication. Candidates not having an e-mail-ID must create an ID and check it regularly for further communication.

5. Information uploaded on the University Website shall not be provided to the candidates under RTI Act, 2005 amended from time to time. The uploaded information on the University Website shall remain for a specific period only. Therefore, the candidates are advised to download the information and keep them for future reference. In due course of recruitment examination, in midway of process neither any application under Right to Information Act, 2005 shall be entertained nor information shall be provided. Factual information under RTI Act shall be provided only after declaration of final result. Reply of inferential (speculative) question shall not be provided.
6. Corrigendum or Addendum or Cancellation etc., to this advertisement, if any, shall be published only on the University Website www.cuk.ac.in and will not be published in the newspapers. Therefore, the candidates are advised to check the University Website regularly.
