1. REMUNERATION PER MONTH (CONSOLIDATED)

The engagement is purely on temporary basis for a period of one semester only. For the engagement on contractual basis, faculty shall be paid a remuneration of Rs. 40,000/- for candidates possessing UGC/CSIR- NET and Rs. 45,000/- for candidates possessing UGC/CSIR- NET along with Ph.D. in the relevant subject.

No other emoluments/allowances/Medical reimbursement are applicable. No vacation salary is payable; No Compensatory leaves are applicable.

QUALIFICATIONS, EXPERIENCE, ROSTER POINTS ETC.

CANDIDATES MAY NOTE THAT THE QUALIFICATIONS / EXPERIENCE / ROSTER POINTS AS PRESCRIBED BY THE UGC/MoE/DOPT/NCTE/AICTE

AND OTHER GOVERNING BODIES FROM TIME TO TIME IS APPLICABLE. APPLICANTS ARE ADVISED TO VISIT THE UGC WEBSITE (www.ugc.ac.in), MoE, AICTE, NCTE etc. AND CONCERN WEBSITES FOR LATEST REVISIONS / CHANGES IN THE SAME WHICH WILL BE APPLICABLE AT THE TIME OF INTERVIEW.

I. MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS (All subjects except Management/Business Studies and Engineering) :

i) A Master 's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.

ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission

(Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET :

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:-

- a. The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b. The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c. An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d. The proof of having completed the course work as per UGC norms.
- e. The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- f. The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC / ICSSR/ CSIR or any similar agency.

Note:

NET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR.

The Ph.D. degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

Note:

The Academic score as specified in Appendix II (Table 3A) for Universities, and Appendix II (Table 3B) for Colleges shall be considered for short-listing of the candidates for interview only, and the selections shall be based only on the performance in the interview.

GENERAL Information

1. Reservations for SC, ST, OBC, EWS and Persons with Disabilities will be as per the existing Government of India norms as amended from time to time. Candidates applying for the reserved posts should clearly state to which category they belong. They must also enclose a Certificate issued by Tahsildar/Mandal Revenue Officer/Equivalent authority as proof to this effect, without which the application will not be considered. In case a candidate wants to claim benefits under the Persons with Disabilities (PWD) category,

the candidate's relevant disability should be not less than 40%. Proof to this effect, must be enclosed with the application, without which the application will be treated as 'General (unreserved)'.

Candidates applying for the post(s) reserved for OBC, should submit a self-attested copy of valid caste certificate specifically mentioning Creamy Layer-exclusion in the format prescribed by Govt. of India (www.ncbc.nic.in, which should not be more than 6 months old from the last date of submission of application) issued by competent authority, vide Column 3 of GOI Dept. of Personnel and Training O.M. No. 36012/22/93-Estt.(SCT) dated 8.9.1993 and modified vide DoPT's O.M. No. 36033/3/2004- Estt.(Res) dated 9.3.2004, subsequently revised vide O.M. No.36033/3/2004-Estt.(Res) dated 14.10.2008. The OBC Certificate must be in the format as prescribed by the Govt. of India vide OM No. 36036/2/2013- Estt. (Res.) dated 30/05/2014.

2. A relaxation of 5% (i.e., from 60% to 55% for Management and Engineering disciplines and 55% to 50% for rest of the disciplines) shall be provided at the Graduate and Masters level for the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes/Persons with Disability (PWD /Other Backward Classes (OBC) (Non-creamy layer) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.
3. Relaxation in Age, Percentage etc., will only be considered in the reserved category posts.
4. Each Eligible candidate has to fill only one application for the one particular post. The same application shall be considered for both unreserved and reserved post if the candidate from reserved category is eligible for unreserved post.
5. Candidates must write their Email ID neatly and correctly for mailing written examination/ interview/appointment letter as attachment. The e-mail date will be considered as the official date of dispatch and receipt of communication. Candidates not having an e-mail-ID must create an ID and check it regularly for further communication. Application form available on University website www.cuk.ac.in
6. The University shall verify the antecedents or documents submitted at any time at the time of engagement or during the tenure of service. In case, it is detected that the documents submitted are fake or the candidate has clandestine antecedents/background and has suppressed the said information, his/her services shall be terminated forthwith.
7. Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET.
8. Fake/derecognized Institutions: Candidates, who have obtained degrees or diplomas or certificates for various courses from any Institution declared fake/derecognized by the University Grants Commission, New Delhi shall not be eligible for being considered for recruitment to the posts advertised.
9. No person shall be recruited unless he/she is in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect that is likely to interfere with the efficient performance of his official duties. Before a candidate recruited directly is finally approved for appointment to the establishment he shall be required to produce a medical certificate of physical fitness from whom the appointing authority specifies.
10. Retired teachers, below the age of 65 may also apply.
11. Candidates offered the position will have to join within one week and should produce the original marks cards and testimonials along with address proof at the time of joining.
12. Original grade card / Marks sheet of Ph.D. Course work must be produced wherever applicable.

13. Age qualifications, etc. shall be reckoned as on the last date of submission of application form/date of Interview.
14. No increment/enhancement of remuneration on account of completion of Ph.D. will be entertained during the period of Semester / Contract.
15. Errors and omissions in notification and selection process are subject to corrections.
16. The University has no compulsion to issue an experience certificate having worked as contract faculty. The work order itself shall be the proof for such request.
17. The University reserves the right to withdraw any advertised post(s) at any time without giving any reason or change or alter the number of vacancies against any of the posts advertised or not to fill any vacancy.
18. At the time of Interview candidates have to produce the original certificates / testimonials / books / published research papers/etc.
19. In case of any dispute/ambiguity that may occur in the process of selection, the decision of the University shall be final.
20. No interim correspondence shall be entertained.
21. Candidates appointed shall not be entitled to claim for any weightage for regular appointment / position in the University at a later date.
22. Candidates are strongly advised to visit the University website regularly www.cuk.ac.in for any addendum, corrigendum and modification etc. The notifications will be modified if any on the university website only.
23. Selected candidates must submit a copy of PAN card at the time of joining/ within a period of one month to release the payment.
24. Anything not covered above shall be governed by UGC/MHRD/GOI norms issued from time to time.
25. The remuneration is given for the classes / practical including evaluation process
26. For hourly basis, the remuneration maximum ceiling per month per faculty is Rs. 25000/-.
27. Selected Contractual / Hourly basis faculty would be given workload as per UGC norms and must work full time from the campus during the tenure of engagement and should have their online teaching arrangements like own laptop etc.
28. Legal disputes if any will be subject to Kalaburagi jurisdiction only.
